Last academic year saw the introduction of the more challenging Key Stage 1 and Key Stage 2 assessments. Instead of levels, children are now assessed across the key stage against specific objectives. We have been working hard with other schools and the local authority to devise and embed a system of tracking children's attainment and progress without levels. All children responded incredibly well to the new challenges of the curriculum and assessment system. They demonstrated resilience and independence and the school are extremely proud of each and every one of their efforts.
