Reading is such an important part of your child's education and when they can read securely they can access so much more information and education as they move through the school. As a school, we want to make sure we are giving your child the best opportunities to become a fluent confident reader. The reading badge scheme encourages reading regularly at home. Children are awarded special coloured reading badges as they read a certain amount of books at home.

	10 books read at home
	20 books read at home
	40 books read at home
	60 books read at home
	80 books read at home
	100 books read at home
Star Reader Badge	200 books read at home

Your child will receive their first badge when they have read 10 books at home and each time they read it is written in their reading log. You will have seen lots of children wearing these badges as we started this scheme a long time ago, or maybe your child has come home with one already.

Please do keep remembering to read with your child at home and support their learning in this way. They will only get the reading badges if the diary is signed.

Please remember to read regularly or ideally daily with your child and record it in the light blue reading diary. We will be starting to send home slips on a Friday if we notice your child has not read that week or has not brought in their reading diary.

If your child's reading diary is lost, you need new books or how to sign into bug club, please ring the office who will able to pass the message to your child's teacher.
